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COMMENT AND REPLY COMMENT DATES SET FOR SIGNIFICANTLY VIEWED STATIONS NPRM

On March 31, 2020, the Federal Communications Commission released a *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM)* seeking comment on modernizing the methodology for determining whether a television broadcast station is “significantly viewed” in a community outside of its local television market.¹ The *NPRM* set deadlines for filing comments and reply comments at 30 and 60 days, respectively, after publication of the *NPRM* in the Federal Register.

The Media Bureau announces that the *NPRM* was published in the Federal Register on April 14, 2020.² Accordingly, comments must be submitted by May 14, 2020; reply comments must be submitted by June 15, 2020. Commenters must follow the filing instructions set forth in paragraph 22 of the *NPRM*.³
