CONSUMER AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS BUREAU ANNOUNCES COMMENT DATES FOR THE PSAP DO-NOT-CALL REGISTRY FURTHER NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

On October 1, 2021, the Commission released a Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to reassess its approach to protect Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) from unwanted autodialed calls.¹ Specifically, the Commission proposed that voice service providers be required to block autodialed calls made to PSAP telephone numbers registered on the PSAP Do-Not-Call registry.²

On November 1, 2021, a summary of the *PSAP DNC FNPRM* was published in the Federal Register.³ Accordingly, comments are due on or before **December 1, 2021**, and reply comments are due on or before **December 16, 2021**. Complete comment filing instructions are set forth in the *PSAP DNC FNPRM*.⁴
