## FCC ANNOUNCES NOVEMBER 7, 2022 MEETING OF THE COMMUNICATIONS EQUITY AND DIVERSITY COUNCIL

In accordance with the Federal Advisory Committee Act,<sup>1</sup> this Public Notice announces the November 7, 2022, meeting of the Federal Communications Commission's (Commission) Communications Equity and Diversity Council (CEDC or Council). The CEDC meeting will be held virtually, beginning at 1:00 pm EST, and will be available to the public for viewing via the Internet at <http://www.fcc.gov/live>.

The agenda for the meeting will include a report of the Digital Empowerment and Inclusion Working Group, including recommendations, for addressing digital discrimination and other barriers that impact equitable access to broadband and other emerging technology in under-served and under-connected communities.<sup>2</sup>

The CEDC meeting will be convened in an online format and will be available to the public via live feed from the FCC's web page at [www.fcc.gov/live](http://www.fcc.gov/live).
