**PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES  
COMMENT AND REPLY COMMENT DATES FOR THE NOTICE OF INQUIRY ON SECURE  
INTERNET ROUTING**

**PS Docket No. 22-90**

**Comments Due: April 11, 2022**  
**Reply Comments Due: May 10, 2022**

On February 28, 2022, the Federal Communications Commission adopted a Notice of Inquiry seeking comment on Secure Internet Routing.<sup>1</sup> The *Notice* seeks comment on potential vulnerabilities threatening the security and integrity of the Border Gateway Protocol, and how best to address them.<sup>2</sup> The *Notice* set deadlines for filing comments and reply comments at 30 and 60 days, respectively, after publication of a summary of the *Notice* in the Federal Register.<sup>3</sup>

On March 11, 2022, the Office of the Federal Register published a summary of the *Notice*, including the associated comment and reply comment dates.<sup>4</sup> Accordingly, comments must be filed on or before April 11, 2022, and reply comments must be filed on or before May 10, 2022. The *Notice* contains the comment filing instructions.<sup>5</sup>
