PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES COMMENT AND REPLY COMMENT DATES FOR THE FURTHER NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING ON WIRELESS EMERGENCY ALERTS

PS Docket Nos. 15-91, 15-94

Comments Due: June 21, 2022 Reply Comments Due: July 19, 2022

On April 21, 2022, the Federal Communications Commission adopted a Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking seeking comment on Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEA).¹ The *Further Notice* proposes that commercial mobile service providers that participate in WEA report on key metrics that will help stakeholders develop an understanding of WEA's end-to-end performance,² and seeks comment on ways to improve WEA's consistency and the pace at which messages are received.³ The *Further Notice* set deadlines for filing comments and reply comments at 30 and 60 days, respectively, after publication of a summary of the *Notice* in the Federal Register.⁴

On May 20, 2022, the Office of the Federal Register published a summary of the *Notice*, including the associated comment and reply comment dates.⁵ Accordingly, comments must be filed on or before June 21, 2022, and reply comments must be filed on or before July 19, 2022. The *Further Notice* contains the comment filing instructions.⁶
