## COMMENT DATES FOR PROPOSED 2023 MANDATORY DATA COLLECTION FOR INCARCERATED PEOPLE'S COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

Comments Due: June 2, 2023

Reply Comments Due: June 20, 2023

By this Public Notice, the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) announces the comment and reply comment dates for the Public Notice on the proposed 2023 Mandatory Data Collection for incarcerated people's communications services.

The Bureau released a Public Notice on April 28, 2023 seeking comment on the contours and specific requirements of the proposed 2023 Mandatory Data Collection implementing the Martha Wright-Reed Just and Reasonable Communications Act of 2022.¹ The *Public Notice* requires that comments and reply comments be filed no later than 30 and 45 days after publication in the Federal Register.² On May 3, 2023, the Federal Register published a summary of the *Public Notice* titled "Wireline Competition Bureau and the Office of Economics and Analytics Seek Comment on Proposed 2023 Mandatory Data Collection for Incarcerated People's Communications Services."³ The May 3, 2023 *Federal Register Notice* establishes **June 2, 2023** as the deadline for comments and **June 20, 2023** as the deadline for reply comments.⁴ The *Public Notice* and *Federal Register Notice* contain complete filing instructions.⁵
