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PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES EFFECTIVE DATE FOR MANDATORY ELECTRONIC FILING OF CALEA SYSTEM SECURITY AND INTEGRITY PLANS

On May 15, 2023, the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (Bureau) released an *Order* amending Section 1.20005¹ of the Commission's rules to require electronic filing of new and updated System Security and Integrity (SSI) plans by entities subject to the Communications Assistance for Law Enforcement Act (CALEA).² On May 30, 2023, the Office of the Federal Register published a summary of the *Order*.³ Accordingly, the effective date for the rule adopted in the *Order* is June 29, 2023.⁴
