Re: Response Required – Potential Dismissal of International Section 214 Application Filed by Content Guru Inc., File No. ITC-214-20220714-00082

Dear Mr. Kabealo:

On June 14, 2022, Content Guru Inc. (Content Guru) filed the above referenced application with the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) to obtain an international section 214 authorization.<sup>1</sup> On August 29, 2022, the Committee for the Assessment of Foreign Participation in the United States Telecommunications Service Sector (Committee) notified the Commission that it was reviewing Content Guru's application for any national security or law enforcement concerns.<sup>2</sup>

On June 7, 2023, the Committee returned the application to the Commission, recommending the application be dismissed without prejudice.<sup>3</sup> The Committee states that Content Guru has failed to respond to a request for information. According to the Committee, it granted Content Guru three extensions to provide the information and warned Content Guru that no further extension would be granted if Content Guru failed to meet its last deadline of June 6, 2023.<sup>4</sup> The Committee states that the

applicant missed the June 6, 2023, deadline.<sup>5</sup> According to the Committee, it cannot complete its review of the application and has returned the application to the Commission with a recommendation it be dismissed without prejudice.<sup>6</sup>

The Committee's recommendation regarding the national security and law enforcement concerns with an application with foreign ownership is an important consideration in the Commission's determination of whether the grant of an application is in the public interest. <sup>7</sup> If the Committee is unable to make a recommendation because the applicant does not provide the required information to the Committee, the Commission will not have the information it needs to find that the grant of the application is in the public interest.

Content Guru must respond to this letter by **July 28, 2023**. In your letter, state whether you intend to pursue the application and if so, indicate when you will provide the Committee with the information it has requested. If you do not respond to this letter, the above referenced application will be dismissed without prejudice pursuant to the Commission's rules.<sup>8</sup>

The Commission is notified that the Committee for the Assessment of Foreign Participation in the United States Telecommunications Services Sector ("Committee") recommends that the above-referenced application be dismissed without prejudice.<sup>1</sup>

The Committee makes this recommendation under subsection 5(d) of Executive Order 13913 (Apr. 4, 2020) ("E.O. 13913") because of Content Guru's failure to respond to a request for information. The Committee previously granted Content Guru three extensions to provide this information under subsection 5(d) of E.O. 13913<sup>2</sup> and warned Content Guru that no further extension would be granted if Content Guru failed to meet its last deadline of June 6, 2023. Content Guru missed that deadline and has not to date provided the requested information. Accordingly, the Committee cannot complete its review and is returning this application to the FCC with a recommendation it be dismissed without prejudice.
