## NOTICE CONCERNING *EX PARTE* STATUS OF INFORMATION SUBMITTED TO THE NORTH AMERICAN NUMBERING COUNCIL

### WC Docket No. 23-1

The North American Numbering Council (NANC) is a federal advisory committee created to advise the Federal Communications Commission (FCC or Commission) on topics related to telephone numbering and make recommendations that foster efficient and impartial number administration.<sup>1</sup> It is organized under, and operates in accordance with, the provisions of the Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA).<sup>2</sup>

Under the FACA, the Commission is responsible for oversight of the NANC, including its working groups and any subcommittees.<sup>3</sup> As a result, FCC Commissioners and staff may participate in or attend meetings or other activities held by both the NANC and its working groups and subcommittees. For this reason, we hereby announce that, pursuant to section 1.1200(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 1.1200(a), presentations to the NANC, including to its working groups and subcommittees, and at any roundtable discussions sponsored by the NANC, as well as presentations between NANC members (including members of any working groups and subcommittees) and FCC Commissioners or staff incidental to and in connection with such NANC meetings or roundtable discussions, will be treated as exempt presentations for *ex parte* purposes.<sup>4</sup> This exemption covers presentations from NANC members to FCC Commissioners and staff in other settings only to the extent that the NANC members are presenting the views of the NANC or its working groups, as opposed to an individual member's own views or that of a member's organization. We find that this modification of the *ex parte* rules is in the public interest because it will allow the NANC to develop and shape its advice and recommendations to the Commission more efficiently and effectively. Furthermore, this treatment is consistent with that

afforded to prior advisory committees. The treatment of *ex parte* presentations specified in this notice shall apply to this and future terms of the NANC unless modified by a subsequent public notice.<sup>5</sup>

We recognize that some issues may be addressed by the NANC that are the subject of pending FCC proceedings.<sup>6</sup> The Commission will not rely in these proceedings on any information submitted to the NANC, or to any of its working groups, subcommittees or sponsored roundtables, or information conveyed by NANC members (including members of any working groups and subcommittees) to FCC Commissioners or staff unless that information is first placed in the record of the relevant proceeding, either by the Commission or the party submitting the information.
