EFFECTIVE DATE FOR FM BROADCAST BOOSTER STATION RULES

Effective Date: May 16, 2024

On April 2, 2024, the Commission released a Report and Order in this proceeding and revised its rules to permit limited, voluntary program origination on FM booster stations.¹ The R&O established that the revised rules would become effective 30 days after publication of the R&O in the Federal Register.²

By this *Public Notice*, the Media Bureau announces that the R&O was published in the Federal Register on April 16, 2024.³ Accordingly, the R&O and the amendments to the rules adopted and set forth in Appendix B therein are effective as of May 16, 2024.
