MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER AND NOTICE OF APPARENT LIABILITY FOR FORFEITURE

Adopted: August 23, 2024 Released: August 23, 2024

By the Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Media Bureau (Bureau) has before it the Application¹ of Southern Broadcasting & Investment Co., Inc. (Licensee) for renewal of its license for Station WBTY(FM), Homerville, Georgia (Station). In this *Memorandum Opinion and Order and Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* (NAL),² we find that Licensee apparently willfully violated section 73.3539³ of the Commission's rules (Rules) by failing to file a timely license renewal application for the Station. Based upon our review of the facts and the record before us, we conclude that Licensee is apparently liable for a monetary forfeiture in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000).

II. BACKGROUND

2. Section 73.3539(a) of the Rules requires that applications for renewal of license for broadcast stations must be filed "not later than the first day of the fourth full calendar month prior to the expiration date of the license sought to be renewed." An application for the renewal of the Station's license should have been filed by December 1, 2019, the first day of the fourth full calendar month prior to the Station's April 1, 2020, license expiration date. The Application was not filed until March 30, 2020. The Licensee provides no explanation for its untimely filing of the Application.

III. DISCUSSION

3. *Proposed Forfeiture*. In this case, the Licensee failed to file the Application on or before December 1, 2019, as required by section 73.3539(a) of the Rules. The Application was not received

until March 30, 2020. Moreover, as noted above, Licensee did not provide an explanation for the late filing.

- 4. This *NAL* is issued pursuant to section 503(b)(1)(B) of the Act. Under that provision, a person who is found to have willfully or repeatedly failed to comply with any provision of the Act or any rule, regulation, or order issued by the Commission shall be liable to the United States for a forfeiture penalty.⁶ Section 312(f)(1) of the Act defines willful as "the conscious and deliberate commission or omission of [any] act, irrespective of any intent to violate" the law.⁷ The legislative history to section 312(f)(1) of the Act clarifies that this definition of willful applies to both sections 312 and 503(b) of the Act,⁸ and the Commission has so interpreted the term in the section 503(b) context.⁹
- 5. The Commission's *Forfeiture Policy Statement* and section 1.80(b)(11) of the Rules establish a base forfeiture amount of \$3,000 for the failure to file a required form.¹⁰ In determining the appropriate forfeiture amount, we may adjust the base amount upward or downward by considering the factors enumerated in section 503(b)(2)(E) of the Act, including "the nature, circumstances, extent and gravity of the violation, and, with respect to the violator, the degree of culpability, any history of prior offenses, ability to pay, and such other matters as justice may require."¹¹
- 6. In this case, the Licensee failed to file a timely renewal application for the Station and has not provided any explanation for its untimely filing. However, the Licensee did file the Application prior to the expiration of the Station's license. Taking into consideration all of the factors required by section 503(b)(2)(E) of the Act and the Forfeiture Policy Statement, we propose a forfeiture for the full \$3,000 amount for the failure to file a timely renewal application.

IV. ORDERING CLAUSES

- 7. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED**, pursuant to section 503(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 503(b), and sections 0.61, 0.204, 0.283, and 1.80 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR §§ 0.61, 0.204, 0.283, and 1.80, that Southern Broadcasting & Investment Co., Inc., is hereby **NOTIFIED** of its **APPARENT LIABILITY FOR FORFEITURE** in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for its apparent willful violation of section 73.3539 of the Commission's rules.
- 8. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, pursuant to section 1.80 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 1.80, within thirty (30) days of the release date of this *NAL*, Southern Broadcasting & Investment Co., Inc., **SHALL PAY** the full amount of the proposed forfeiture or **SHALL FILE** a written statement seeking reduction or cancellation of the proposed forfeiture.
- 9. Payment of the forfeiture must be made by credit card, ACH (Automated Clearing House) debit from a bank account using CORES (the Commission's online payment system), 12 or by wire transfer. Payments by check or money order to pay a forfeiture are no longer accepted. **Upon payment, Southern Broadcasting & Investment Co., Inc. must send notice that payment has been made to**

The written response seeking reduction or cancellation of the proposed forfeiture, if any, must include a detailed factual statement supported by appropriate documentation and affidavits pursuant to sections 1.16 and 1.80(g)(3) of the Rules, 47 CFR §§ 1.16 and 1.80(g)(3). The written response must be filed with the Office of the Secretary, Federal Communications Commission, 45 L Street, NE, Washington, DC 20554, Alexander Sanjenis and MUST INCLUDE the NAL/Acct. No. referenced above. A copy must also be emailed to Alexander.Sanjenis@fcc.gov and Ariane.Rangel@fcc.gov to assist in processing the response.
 - Filings can be sent by hand or messenger delivery, by commercial courier, or by the U.S. Postal Service. All filings must be addressed to the Secretary, Federal Communications Commission.

- 9050 Junction Drive, Annapolis Junction, MD 20701. All hand deliveries must be held together with rubber bands or fasteners. Any envelopes and boxes must be disposed of before entering the building.¹⁵
- O Commercial overnight mail (other than U.S. Postal Service Express Mail and Priority Mail) must be sent to 9050 Junction Drive, Annapolis Junction, MD 20701.
- Postal Service first-class, Express, and Priority mail must be addressed to 45 L Street, NE, Washington, DC 20554.
- 11. The Commission will not consider reducing or canceling a forfeiture in response to a claim of inability to pay unless the respondent submits: (1) federal tax returns for the most recent three-year period; (2) financial statements prepared according to generally accepted accounting practices (GAAP); or (3) some other reliable and objective documentation that accurately reflects the respondent's current financial status. Any claim of inability to pay must specifically identify the basis for the claim by reference to the financial documentation submitted. Inability to pay, however, is only one of several factors that the Commission will consider in determining the appropriate forfeiture, and we have discretion to not reduce or cancel the forfeiture if other prongs of 47 U.S.C. § 503(b)(2)(E) support that result.¹⁶
- 12. Requests for full payment of the forfeiture proposed in this *NAL* under the installment plan should be sent to: Associate Managing Director-Financial Operations, 45 L Street, NE, Washington, DC 20554.¹⁷ Requests can be sent by hand or messenger delivery, by commercial courier, or by the U.S. Postal Service in the manner specified above.
