## **FCC ANNOUNCES THE FIFTH MEETING OF THE NINTH COMMUNICATIONS SECURITY, RELIABILITY, AND INTEROPERABILITY COUNCIL ON JUNE 12, 2025**

This Public Notice serves as an announcement that, consistent with the Federal Advisory Committee Act,<sup>1</sup> the Federal Communications Commission (FCC or Commission) will hold the fifth meeting of the Communications Security, Reliability and Interoperability Council IX (CSRIC IX or Council) on **June 12, 2025, beginning at 1:00 pm EDT, at the FCC, 45 L Street, N.E., Washington, D.C., and via video conference call.** Notice of this meeting was published in the Federal Register on May 23, 2025.<sup>2</sup>

At the fifth meeting, two reports will be presented to the membership for deliberation and a vote: working group 1 will present a Report on Threats Posed by Artificial Intelligence/Machine Learning Systems to the Security, Reliability and Integrity of Networks and Recommendations on How to Overcome Them and working group 2 will present a Report on Connecting Stalled 911 Calls Through Alternative Network Options. The third working group will make a presentation on their progress in addressing the task on Preparing for 6G Security and Reliability. The CSRIC IX meeting is open to the public, but all guests must check-in with and be screened by FCC security at the main entrance on L Street. Attendees will not be required to have an appointment but must otherwise comply with protocols outlined at: <https://www.fcc.gov/visit>. Members of the news media are welcome to attend the meeting.

The CSRIC IX meeting will also be streamed via live feed at <https://www.fcc.gov/live>. Open captioning will be provided for this event.
