**ORDER**

By the Assistant Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau:

1. This *Order* amends the Table of FM Allotments (“FM Table”)<sup>1</sup> to remove certain vacant FM allotment channels that are no longer considered vacant FM allotments. The attached Appendix shows the FM Table, as amended, for those communities.

2. The FM allotments listed in the Appendix are currently authorized licensed stations. FM assignments for authorized stations and reserved facilities will be reflected solely in the Media Bureau’s Licensing Management System (LMS).<sup>2</sup>

3. These FM allotment channels have previously undergone notice and comment rulemaking. This action constitutes an editorial change in the Table of FM Allotments. Therefore, a public notice and comment proceedings are unnecessary.<sup>3</sup>

4. The Commission will not send a copy of this *Order* pursuant to the Congressional Review Act, *see* 5 U.S.C. 801(a)(1)(A), because the adopted rules are rules of particular applicability.

5. **Ordering Clauses.** Accordingly, pursuant to the authority found in 47 U.S.C. sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) and 47 C.F.R. sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283, IT IS ORDERED, That effective, upon publication in the Federal Register, the Table of FM Allotments, 47 CFR § 73.202(b), IS AMENDED, in accordance with the changes set forth in the Appendix to this *Order*.

ID No. 762409 to specify operation on Channel 277A at Mullin. *See* FCC Application File No. 0000159217; *see also Various Locations*, Order, DA 25-121 (MB 2025), 2025 WL 472469 and 90 FR 9845, published February 19, 2025. WKZY is currently licensed on FM Channel 225A at Chilton, Wisconsin. *See* FCC Application File No. BLH-20121015AAA).
