## EFFECTIVE DATE FOR RULE REQUIRING ALL PROVIDERS TO BLOCK USING A DO-NOT-ORIGINATE LIST SET FOR DECEMBER 15, 2025

### CG Docket No. 17-59

On February 27, 2025, the Commission adopted the *Eighth Report and Order* in the above-captioned proceeding.<sup>1</sup> In this rulemaking, the Commission adopted a new rule requiring all U.S.-based providers in the call path to block calls using a reasonable do-not-originate (DNO) list.<sup>2</sup> This rule is contained in 47 CFR § 64.1200(o).<sup>3</sup>

The *Eighth Report and Order* provided that this rule would become effective 90 days after publication of a notice of Office of Management and Budget (OMB) approval in the Federal Register. OMB approved the information collection requirement on August 5, 2025.<sup>4</sup> A notice of OMB approval was published in the Federal Register on September 16, 2025.<sup>5</sup> The rule's effective date, accordingly, is December 15, 2025, 90 days after the rule was published in the Federal Register.<sup>6</sup>
