**ORDER
(Proceeding Terminated)**

By the Chief, Video Division, Media Bureau:

1. The Video Division, Media Bureau (Bureau), has before it a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (*NPRM*)¹ issued in response to a Petition for Rulemaking (Petition) filed by WLOV License LLC (WLOV),² licensee of full power television station WLOV-TV (Station or WLOV-TV), channel 16, West Point, Mississippi (West Point), requesting that the Bureau substitute channel 26 for channel 16 at West Point in the Table of TV Allotments with the technical parameters specified in the Petition. On September 19, 2025, WLOV filed a Request for Withdrawal of Petition for Rulemaking (Request).³ For the reasons below, we grant the Request, dismiss the Petition, and terminate the proceeding.

2. As explained in the *NPRM*, when WLOV's prior equipment and tower lease agreement expired, the Station relocated to another tower in the market and has since been operating from that tower at reduced power pursuant to special temporary authority.⁴ To return the Station to full power operations, WLOV had reached an agreement with the licensee of a station located at that tower, WCBI-TV, which necessitated the instant channel substitution request in order to enable full power operation and prevent adjacent channel interference.⁵ According to WLOV, since filing its Petition, "WLOV's agreement with the licensee of WCBI-TV has been terminated, and as a result, WLOV no longer intends to relocate the Station to the WCBI-TV tower. WLOV is no longer certain that there will be any need to modify the Station's facilities to operate on Channel 26 and, as a result, hereby requests withdrawal of the Petition."⁶ Pursuant to section 1.420(j) of the Commission's rules,⁷ WLOV includes with its Request a declaration from its President and CEO stating that no written or oral agreement exists between WLOV and any other party related to WLOV's withdrawal of the Petition and neither WLOV nor its principals have received or will receive any consideration in exchange for withdrawal.⁸

4. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Petition for Rulemaking filed by WLOV License LLC **IS DISMISSED**.

5. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that MB Docket No. 25-247 and RM-12008 **SHALL BE TERMINATED** and its docket closed.
