By the Chief, Policy Division, Media Bureau:

1. On April 25, 2024, One Ministries, Inc., (OMI), licensee of commercial television station KQSL, Fort Bragg, California (Facility ID No. 8378) (KQSL), filed an Application for Review1 of the Media Bureau’s April 28, 2023 order2 denying OMI’s Petition for Special Relief3 to modify KQSL’s local television market. On February 12, 2026, OMI filed a request to withdraw its Application for Review.4 We hereby grant OMI’s request and dismiss the Application for Review.

2. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Application for Review referenced above IS DISMISSED and that the above-captioned proceeding IS TERMINATED and the docket is closed.

3. This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated by section 0.283 of the Commission’s rules.5
