**ORDER**

By the Chief, Policy Division, Media Bureau:

1. On April 18, 2026, Gray Local Media, Inc. (Gray), owner of Gray Television Licensee, LLC, licensee of WVLT-TV, Knoxville, TN, filed a complaint against DISH Network L.L.C., alleging unauthorized retransmission of WVLT-TV.<sup>1</sup> On May 4, 2026, Gray filed a request that the Commission dismiss with prejudice the Complaint, indicating that the parties have settled the dispute.<sup>2</sup> In view of the foregoing, we grant Gray’s request.

2. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that Gray Local Media, Inc.’s dismissal request **IS GRANTED** and the Complaint **IS DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**, and that this proceeding **IS TERMINATED** and the docket is closed.

3. This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated by section 0.283 of the Commission’s rules.<sup>3</sup>
