**PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES
REGION 14 (INDIANA) 700 MHZ AND 800 MHZ REGIONAL PLANNING COMMITTEES
TO HOLD SPECIAL MEETINGS ONLINE**

The Region 14 (Indiana)¹ 700 MHz and 800 MHz Regional Planning Committees (RPCs) will hold two consecutive special meetings on Tuesday, June 9, 2026. The purpose of these meetings is to nominate and elect a new Region 14 Chairperson. The current chairperson, Larry Turner, is retiring as of July 2, 2026. These meetings will be held online and can be accessed remotely using the link below.

The Region 14 RPC meetings are open to the public. All public safety providers in Region 14 may utilize these 700 MHz and 800 MHz frequencies. It is essential that eligible public safety agencies in all areas of government, including state, municipality, county, and Tribal Nations be represented in order

to ensure that each agency's future spectrum needs are considered in the allocation process. Administrators who are not oriented in the communications field should delegate someone with this knowledge to attend, participate, and represent their agency's needs.
