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CONSUMER AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS BUREAU ANNOUNCES COMMENT DATES FOR KNOW-YOUR-CUSTOMER FURTHER NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

On May 1, 2026, the Commission released a Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking that seeks comment on information that originating voice service providers must obtain from customers before they make calls, how providers should verify that information, and penalties for violations.¹ The *Notice* sets deadlines for filing comments and reply comments at 30 and 60 days after publication of a summary in the Federal Register.

On May 26, 2026, a summary of the item was published in the Federal Register.² Accordingly, comments are due on or before June 25, 2026 and reply comments are due on or before July 27, 2026. Complete comment filing instructions are set forth in the *Notice*.³
