On January 14, 2026, Link2YU Network LLC dba MTEL USA (MTEL USA) filed an application for authority to provide limited resale service in accordance with section 63.18(e)(2)(ii) of the Commission's rules. 47 CFR § 63.18(e)(2)(ii). Specifically, MTEL USA requests authority to provide resale service on all international routes except to Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, and Kosovo. MTEL USA has filed a separate application for authority to provide service on those routes. *See* ITC-214-20260319-00078. MTEL USA will provide service through the resale of unaffiliated U.S. facilities-based carriers' international switched services. On June 2, 2026, the Applicant filed an amendment clarifying the routes on which it requests authority to provide service pursuant to this application. *See* ITC-AMD-20260319-00079.

MTEL USA, a California limited liability company, is wholly owned by MTEL Global DOO (MTEL Global), a Serbia entity. Telekom Srbija AD (Telekom Srbija), a Serbia entity, holds an 85.7% equity interest and 100% voting interest in MTEL Global through 59% direct equity and voting interests in MTEL Global and indirectly through its 65% direct equity and voting interests in Telekomunikacije Republike Srpske A.D. Banja Luka, a Bosnia and Herzegovina entity, that holds direct 41% equity and voting interests in MTEL Global. The Government of the Republic of Serbia holds direct 58.11% equity and voting interests in Telekom Srbija. In addition, Telekom Srbija holds 20% of its shares as Treasury Shares, which do not confer voting rights. According to the Applicant, no other individual or entity holds a direct or indirect 10% or greater equity or voting interest in MTEL USA.

Pursuant to Commission practice, this Application is being referred to the relevant Executive Branch agencies for their views on any national security, law enforcement, foreign policy, or trade policy concerns related to the foreign ownership of the Applicant.

MTEL USA will provide service through the resale of unaffiliated U.S. facilities-based carriers' international switched services. MTEL USA has filed a separate application for authority to provide resale service on all international routes other than to Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, and Kosovo. *See* ITC-214-20251220-00173.

MTEL USA, a California limited liability company, is wholly owned by MTEL Global DOO (MTEL Global), a Serbia entity. Telekom Srbija AD (Telekom Srbija), a Serbia entity, holds an 85.7% equity interest and 100% voting interest in MTEL Global through 59% direct equity and voting interests in MTEL Global and indirectly through its 65% direct equity and voting interests in Telekomunikacije Republike Srpske A.D. Banja Luka, a Bosnia and Herzegovina entity, that holds direct 41% equity and voting interests in MTEL Global.
