Dear Sir or Madam:

On June 10, 2026, the Spectrum Enforcement Division of the Enforcement Bureau (Division) issued a Letter of Inquiry (LOI) to Odyssey Robot LLC (Odyssey or Company) regarding whether the Company may have marketed radiofrequency (RF) equipment in violation of the Communications Act of 1934 and the Commission's rules.¹ A response to this LOI was due no later than June 24, 2026. We have not received a response to our LOI. Your failure to respond to the LOI constitutes a violation of our rules and may result in enforcement action.² In addition, to knowingly and willfully make any false statement or conceal any material fact in reply to our inquiry is punishable by fine or imprisonment.³

The LOI was sent on June 10, 2026, via certified mail return receipt requested, to Odyssey through its designated US agent for service of process with the contact information filed by the Company with the Commission (21 Miller Alley Suite 210, Pasadena, CA 91103). The information the Company

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filed with the Commission indicates that its business address and the address of its designated US agent for service of process are the same (21 Miller Alley Suite 210, Pasadena, CA 91103). On June 10, 2026, the Division also emailed the LOI to the email address filed by the Company for use in serving the Company's designated US agent for service of process (contact@flyondrone.com). An email delivery receipt indicated that the email was delivered to this email address on June 10, 2026 at 9:05 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time.

Odyssey has had an adequate opportunity to respond to the LOI. The LOI and this follow-up letter constitute orders of the Commission to produce the documents and information requested.⁴ We direct Odyssey, pursuant to sections 4(i), 4(j), and 403 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,⁵ to provide the information and documents originally requested in our LOI no later than **seven calendar days** from the date of this letter. The instructions for responding to the LOI and the definitions for certain terms used in the LOI are contained in a copy of the LOI enclosed herewith. Odyssey must transmit a copy of the response via email to EB-SED-Response@fcc.gov within **seven calendar days**.
