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STREAMLINED RESOLUTION OF REQUESTS RELATED TO ACTIONS BY THE UNIVERSAL SERVICE ADMINISTRATIVE COMPANY

Pursuant to our procedure for resolving requests for review, requests for waiver, and petitions for reconsideration of decisions related to actions taken by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) that are consistent with precedent (collectively, Requests), the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) grants, dismisses, or denies the following Requests.¹ The deadline for filing petitions for reconsideration or applications for review concerning the disposition of any of these Requests is 30 days from the release date of this Public Notice.²

In their petitions, Nancy Fawcett Memorial Library and Tiffin City School District provide more details about the personnel issues that led to their late-filed FCC Forms 471. We note, however, that personnel issues, including the absence of key school or board member employees, does not rise to the level of special circumstances required for a waiver of the Commission's rules. *See, e.g., Requests for Waiver by Nederland Independent School District et al., Federal-State Joint Board on Universal Service, Changes to the Board of Directors of the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc.*, CC Docket Nos. 96-45 and 97-21, Order, 15 FCC Rcd 19544, 19545, para. 2 (WCB 2002) (*Nederland Independent School District Order*) ("[W]e have consistently held that personnel disruptions . . . do not rise to the level of special circumstances required for a waiver."); *Requests for Waiver by Fennville Public Schools, Schools and Libraries Universal Service Support Mechanism*, CC Docket No. 02-6, Order, 19 FCC Rcd 2147, 2148, para. 3 (WCB 2004) (*Fennville Public Schools Order*) (finding that disruptions related to the reorganization of the organization's board are not special circumstances warranting a waiver of the filing window). We therefore deny and dismiss these petitions for reconsideration.

In its petition, Stone County School District asks the Bureau to reinstate canceled funding request number 2699014574 and waive the competitive bidding rules for this funding request. We find that the petitioners were unable to complete implementation for reasons beyond their control and made good faith efforts to comply with Commission rules and procedures. We waive the special construction service delivery deadline and direct USAC to provide Kenowa Hills Public Schools, Las Vegas-Clark County Library District and Sacred Wind Communications, Inc. until June 30, 2027 to complete their special construction projects and direct USAC to provide CENIC-Corporation for Education Network Initiatives in California until September 30, 2026 to complete its special construction project. We also waive any associated administrative or procedural deadlines, including the invoice filing deadline, that might be necessary to effectuate our ruling. See *supra* note 7.
