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WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS AUCTION 113 LICENSES

Auction No. 113

By this Public Notice, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB) announces the grant of 6 long-form applications and issuance of 199 licenses for Auction 113. On June 23, 2026, bidding concluded in the Federal Communications Commission's (Commission's) auction of Advanced Wireless Services (AWS-3) licenses, and the Office of Economics and Analytics (OEA) and the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB) announced the results of that auction on June 26, 2026.¹ This auction raised a total of \$3,572,355,450 in net bids and \$3,572,889,200 in gross bids, with 7 bidders winning a total of 200 licenses.² Long-form applications for licenses won in Auction 113 were due on July 13, 2026. WTB accepted these same 6 Auction 113 applications for filing on August 11, 2026.³

Upon further review and examination, WTB finds the applications for the licenses listed in Attachment A to be complete and in conformance with the Commission's rules. We find that granting the applications for the licenses listed in Attachment A serves the public interest, convenience, and necessity. Furthermore, the Commission has received full payment for the licenses listed in Attachment A, as required by section 1.2109(a) of its rules.⁴ Accordingly, by this Public Notice, we announce the grant of the licenses listed in Attachment A. We grant these licenses pursuant to section 309(a) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 309(a), and sections 0.131 and 0.331 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.131, 0.331.

We remind licensees that they should review all Commission orders and public notices establishing rules and policies for these licenses.⁵ Each licensee is solely responsible for complying with
