3 Billionaires Corporation

On May 1, 2026, 3 Billionaires Corporation (3 Billionaires) filed an application for authority to provide global resale service in accordance with section 63.18(e)(2). 47 CFR § 63.18(e)(2). On August 8, 2026, 3 Billionaires filed an amendment updating and clarifying information in the application regarding 3 Billionaires' ownership. (See ITC-AMD-20260808-00235 in this Public Notice).

3 Billionaires is a New York corporation that seeks authority to provide international telecommunications services as a reseller of telecommunication products and services. 3 Billionaires is wholly owned by Gary Liang, a U.S. citizen. No other person or entity holds a direct or indirect 10% or greater equity, voting, or controlling interest in 3 Billionaires.

On April 2, 2026, Mobi Acquisition LLC (Mobi), a Delaware limited liability company, filed an application for authority to provide global resale service in accordance with section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's rules. 47 CFR § 63.18(e)(2). On May 8, 2026, Mobi submitted an Amendment, ITC-AMD-20260508-00135, to update a name change of the parent company. On May 13, 2026, Applicant filed another Amendment, ITC-AMD-20260513-00138, to update its email address.

Mobi is wholly owned by Minute Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation (Minute). Minute is wholly owned by Ludvig Bartholdsson, a Swedish citizen.

According to Applicant, no other entity or individual holds a ten percent or greater direct or indirect equity or voting interest in Mobi.

Pursuant to Commission practice, this Application is being referred to the relevant Executive Branch agencies for their views on any national security, law enforcement, foreign policy, or trade policy concerns related to the foreign ownership of the Applicant.
