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FCC ANNOUNCES THE SECOND MEETING OF THE TENTH COMMUNICATIONS SECURITY, RELIABILITY, AND INTEROPERABILITY COUNCIL ON SEPTEMBER 23, 2026

This Public Notice serves as an announcement that, consistent with the Federal Advisory Committee Act,¹ the Federal Communications Commission (FCC or Commission) will hold the second meeting of the tenth Communications Security, Reliability and Interoperability Council (CSRIC X or Council) on **Tuesday, September 23, beginning at 1:00 pm EDT, at FCC Headquarters, 45 L Street NE, Washington, D.C., and via video conference call**. Notice of this meeting was published in the Federal Register on August 27, 2026.²

The second meeting will include presentations from the six (6) working group co-chairs announcing their membership and the plans to address their assigned task. The meeting is open to the public and members of the news media. While the CSRIC X meeting is open to the public, all guests must check in with and be screened by FCC security at the main entrance on L Street, NE. Attendees will not be required to have an appointment but must otherwise comply with protocols outlined at: <https://www.fcc.gov/visit>.

The CSRIC X meeting will also be streamed via live feed at <https://www.fcc.gov/live>. Open captioning will be provided for this event. Other reasonable accommodations for people with disabilities are available upon request.
