**REPORT AND ORDER**  
(Proceeding Terminated)

Adopted: December 14, 1989; Released: January 4, 1990

By the Chief, Allocations Branch:

1. At the request of WMHT Educational Telecommunications Corporation (petitioner), licensee of public broadcasting Stations WMHT-FM and WMHT-TV, Schenectady, New York, the Commission has before it the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 2 FCC Rcd 7361 (1987), proposing the deletion of noncommercial educational Channel \*42 from Oneonta, New York, and its reallocation to Kingston, New York, as the community's first local noncommercial educational service.<sup>1</sup> Petitioner filed supporting comments and reply comments. WSKG Public Telecommunications Council, licensee of noncommercial educational Stations WSKG-FM and WSKG-TV ("WSKG"), filed comments and reply comments in opposition.

2. As stated in the Appendix to the *Notice*, continuing interest is required before a channel will be allotted to a community. However, on October 3, 1989, petitioner filed a request to withdraw its petition for rule making, stating that it no longer desires the reallocation of Channel \*42 from Oneonta to Kingston, and that it will not apply for the channel, if reallocated. No other party filed comments expressing an intention to apply for the channel at Kingston. Therefore, we will grant petitioner's request to dismiss its petition.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the petition of WMHT Educational Telecommunications Corporation to reallocate noncommercial educational Channel \*42 from Oneonta to Kingston, New York, IS DISMISSED.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
