2. On October 15, 1991, the Commission adopted a decision acting upon the Court's remand. Decision on Remand, CC Docket No. 86-497, FCC 91-324 (released October 31, 1991) (Rate Base Decision). In light of the Commission's Rate Base Decision there is no further need to hold the captioned cases in abeyance. Accordingly, the pleading and discovery schedules will recommence upon release of this Order. Dates for filing pleadings should be calculated, based on the timetable provided in the rules, from the release date.<sup>2</sup>
