REPORT AND ORDER (Proceeding Terminated)

Adopted: January 13, 1992; Released: January 23, 1992

By the Chief, Allocations Branch:

1. The Commission has before it for consideration the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 6 FCC Rcd 6490 (1991), issued in response to a petition filed by John A. Brush, Yvonne M. Brush and Amy C. Rutledge ("petitioner"). The *Notice* proposed the allotment of Channel 258A to Perham, Minnesota, as that community's first local service. Petitioner filed comments reaffirming its interest in the allotment of Channel 258A to Perham.

2. We believe the public interest would be served by allotting Channel 258A to Perham, Minnesota, as it will provide the community with its first local service. Channel 258A can be allotted to Perham, Minnesota, in compliance with the minimum distance separation requirements of the Commission's Rules without a site restriction.¹ Since Perham is located within 320 kilometers (200 miles) of the U.S.-Canadian border, concurrence of the Canadian government has been obtained for this allotment.

3. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1). 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective March 9, 1992, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the community listed below, to read as follows:

Perham, Minnesota	258A

4. The window period for filing applications for Channel 258A, Perham, Minnesota, will open on March 10, 1992, and close on April 9, 1992.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
