On February 10, 1995, you filed a request for an extension of time for GTE Hawaiian Telephone Company Incorporated (GTE) to file a response to the pole attachment complaint filed by Daniels Communications Partners d/b/a/Hawaiian Cablevision Company, et al.(Daniels), PA 95-009.

You state that good cause exists for granting GTE an extension until February 21 in which to file its response. GTE and the parties to this complaint as well as the parties to the other pole attachment complaints pending against GTE will be discussing the possibility of a global settlement of all the complaints next week. Because of these settlement discussions GTE believes that an extension would promote administrative efficiency and would further the public interest.
