COMMENTS INVITED ON CITIZENS UTILITIES COMPANY'S PETITION FOR WAIVER OF SECTIONS 43.21, 43.22, 64.903 AND 64.904 OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES

On December 4, 1995, Citizens Utilities Company (Citizens) filed a petition for waiver of Sections 43.21, 43.22, 64.903 and 64.904 of the Commission's rules. Citizens seeks a waiver so that its telephone operating divisions may be treated as separate entities for the purposes of the Automated Reporting Management Information System (ARMIS) reporting, Cost Allocation Manual filing and the independent audit requirements. Citizens explains that it is a diversified utility company with gas, water, electric and wastewater operations in addition to its telephone divisions. Citizens states that, under its present corporate structure, the Commission's rules require that the entire company comply with Parts 32, 43 and 64 of the Commission's rules. Citizens states that this compliance would be extraordinarily burdensome and expensive.

Citizens requests a waiver of Sections 43.21, 43.22, 64.903 and 64.904 until it can restructure its telephone divisions as separate legal entities. Citizens states that once its restructuring is complete, none of its telephone operating companies will be subject to compliance with Sections 43.21, 43.22, 64.903 and 64.904 until any of the telephone operating companies reach the \$100 million annual operating revenue threshold.
