PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED FOR COMMENTS ON PETITION OF ABILENE, TEXAS FOR EXPEDITED DECLARATORY RULING

CCBPol 96-19

Released: September 11, 1996

On August 15, 1996, the City of Abilene, Texas (Abilene) filed a petition for expedited declaratory ruling pursuant to section 253(d) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Abilene asks the Federal Communications Commission to declare section 3.251(d) of the Texas Public Utility Regulatory Act of 1995 (PURA 95) violates sections 253(a) and (b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, and is therefore preempted.
