COMMISSION SEEKS COMMENT ON SOUTHWESTERN BELL'S REQUEST FOR A STAY OF CERTAIN CALLER ID REQUIREMENTS

On September 27, 1996, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT") filed a petition for a stay of Section 64.1601(b), of the Commission's rules, as it applies to public pay telephones, hotel/motel lines, centrex/plexar lines and automatic call return services. 47 C.F.R. §1601(b). <u>See Rules and Policies Regarding Calling Number Identification Service -- Caller ID</u>, Memorandum Opinion and Order on Reconsideration, Second Report and Order and Third Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, 10 FCC Rcd 11700 (1995). SWBT seeks the stay until the Commission has made a ruling on issues raised in BellSouth's Petition for Reconsideration and the Third Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.
