PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED FOR COMMENTS ON AMERITECH'S REQUEST FOR WAIVER RELATED TO MINOR AMENDMENT TO AMERITECH'S PLAN TO PROVIDE CEI TO PROVIDERS OF VOICE MAIL MESSAGING SERVICE

On October 28, 1996, Ameritech filed a supplement to a minor amendment to its Comparably Efficient Interconnection Plan for Voice Mail Messaging Service. Ameritech's minor amendment was filed on August 26, 1996. In its supplement, Ameritech seeks a limited waiver of the Commission's Computer II rules to begin offering its customers a new feature effective November 13, 1996, rather than December 6, 1996, as those rules require.
