AMERITECH'S REQUEST FOR WAIVER RELATED TO
MINOR AMENDMENT TO AMERITECH'S PLAN TO PROVIDE CEI TO
PROVIDERS OF VOICE MAIL MESSAGING SERVICE**

On October 28, 1996, Ameritech filed a supplement to a minor amendment to its Comparably Efficient Interconnection Plan for Voice Mail Messaging Service. Ameritech's minor amendment was filed on August 26, 1996. In its supplement, Ameritech seeks a limited waiver of the Commission's Computer II rules to begin offering its customers a new feature effective November 13, 1996, rather than December 6, 1996, as those rules require.
