PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED FOR COMMENTS ON AMERITECH'S COMPARABLY EFFICIENT INTERCONNECTION PLAN FOR PAYPHONE SERVICE PROVIDERS

CC Docket No. 96-128

On November 27, 1996, Ameritech filed a Comparably Efficient Interconnection (CEI) plan for providers of pay telephone services in accordance with Commission requirements imposed in *Implementation of the Pay Telephone Reclassification and Compensation Provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996*, CC Docket No. 96-128, Report and Order, FCC 96-388, released Sept. 20, 1996, and Order on Reconsideration, FCC 96-439 released Nov. 8, 1996.

Interested parties should file comments on Ameritech's proposed CEI plan for payphone services providers by **January 3, 1996**, and reply comments by **January 17, 1997**, with the Secretary, FCC, 1919 M Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20554.
