FCC RENEWS, AMENDS AND RENAMES EBSAC CHARTER

In accordance with the GSA Final Rule on Federal advisory committee management, 41 CFR Sec. 101-6.1015, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) is giving official notice of the renewal of the Emergency Broadcast System Advisory Committee (EBSAC) which is being renamed the National Advisory Committee (NAC). The term of this advisory committee runs from July 25, 1996 to July 25, 1998.

The FCC is also amending the charter for this advisory committee to reflect changes resulting from the new Emergency Alert System (EAS), and to change the name of the committee to the National Advisory Committee (NAC).

The NAC advises the FCC on matters concerning the Emergency Alert System including policies, technologies, plans, regulations and procedures for the EAS.
