Sonitrol Southeast, Inc. Seeks Commission Determination of "Exempt Telecommunications Company" Status Under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935, As Amended by Section 103 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996

On May 23, 1997, Sonitrol Southeast, Inc., pursuant to Section 34(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 ('PUHCA'), as added by Section 103 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Pub. L. No. 104-104, filed an application requesting a Commission determination that it is *z*<sub>11</sub> "exempt telecommunications company" ('ETC'). Sonitrol Southeast is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sentry Alarms Systems of America, Inc., which, in turn, is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sentry Management Corporation an Exempt Telecommunications Company under Section 34(a)(1) of PUHCA (see **Sentry Management Corporation, Order,** DA 96-1926, File No. ETC 96-17, Released November 19, 1996).

Persons wishing to file comments regarding the adequacy or accuracy of Sonitrol Southeast's application requesting status as an ETC must do so no later than **June 11, 1997.** All comments should also be served on the applicant. Reply comments must be filed no later than **June 18, 1997.** All filings concerning any of the matters referenced in this Public Notice should refer to File No. ETC-97-9.
