PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED FOR COMMENTS ON SWBT PETITION FOR FORBEARANCE FROM APPLICATION OF SECTION 272 OF THE ACT TO PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED SERVICES

On June 4, 1997, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) filed a petition for forbearance, pursuant to section 10 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (Act).
