**ORDER EXTENDING TIME**

1. Pursuant to section 1.46 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.46, The Committee on Democratic Communications of the National Lawyers Guild ("National Lawyers Guild") has moved for an extension of the March 9, 1998 date for filing comments in the above-captioned proceeding. National Lawyers Guild maintains that the extension is necessary because of the unusually complex nature of the proposal, and to ensure the participation of numerous interested parties who are generally unfamiliar with the Commission's procedures. For the reasons stated, we hereby grant National Lawyers Guild's motion for an extension of time in which to file comments in this proceeding.
