Notice of a Prohibited Ex Parte Presentation in the Matter of Petitions filed by Jovon Broadcasting Corporation, Roberts Broadcasting Company, and Urban Broadcasting in the Roy M. This is to provide notice in accordance with Section 1.1212(f) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1212(f), of a written ex parte presentation dated March 12, 1998, signed by a number of members of Congress directed to the merits of the above-referenced restricted proceedings. The ex parte rules (47 C.F.R. §§ 1.1200-12) prohibit written communications to Commission decision-making personnel directed to the merits or outcome of any proceedings classified as "restricted" unless the communications are served on all parties to the proceeding. Because the communication was not served on the parties to these proceedings, it is a prohibited ex parte presentation.
