**ORDER**

By the Chief, Commercial Wireless Division:

1. By this Order, we dismiss the petitions for reconsideration<sup>1</sup> filed by David E. Huffman (Huffman) in the above-referenced matter. On June 28, 1994, Huffman filed a finder's preference request targeting Station WNXR246, Natchez, MS, which is licensed to NICOMM, Inc. (NICOMM). NICOMM opposed the finder's preference request. On December 6, 1996, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's Office of Operations dismissed Huffman's finder's preference request.<sup>2</sup>

2. Huffman, acting *per se*, filed two petitions for reconsideration against the dismissal of his finder's preference request. The petitions were filed on January 6, 1997 and March 3, 1997. On July 24, 1997, Huffman filed a Request to Dismiss both of his petitions. The submission of Huffman's Request to Dismiss these petitions renders the petitions moot. The Division has reviewed and approves the withdrawal of the petitions for reconsideration.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sections 4(i) and 405 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i) and 405, and sections 1.106 and 90.173(k) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.106 and 90.173(k), the petitions for reconsideration filed by David E. Huffman on January 6, 1997 and March 3, 1997 ARE DISMISSED.
