## By the Deputy Chief, Policy and Program Planning Division:

1. On October 8, 1999, BellSouth Corporation (BellSouth) filed a pleading styled as "BellSouth Petition for Forbearance" in which BellSouth sought forbearance from enforcement of section 272 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, with respect to its provision of national directory assistance service.
