ERRATUM

1. On May 30, 1997, the Commission released a *Memorandum Opinion and Order* in the above captioned proceeding (FCC 97-168). The *Memorandum Opinion and Order* addresses service quality and infrastructure reporting issues raised in petitions filed by seven incumbent local exchange carriers, the Telecommunications Association, the International Communications Association, and the Consumer Federation of America. These petitions sought reconsideration of the Common Carrier Bureau's *Service Quality Modification Order*. This erratum amends the *Memorandum Opinion and Order*.

2. The first line of paragraph 56 of the *Memorandum Opinion and Order* states, that "we should require tariffing of service quality standards." The word "not" is hereby inserted after the word "should" in the first sentence of paragraph 56.
