PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED FOR COMMENTS ON SECTION 252(e)(5) PETITION FILED BY STARPOWER COMMUNICATIONS

On March 16, 2000, Starpower Communications, LLC (Starpower) filed a petition pursuant section 252(e)(5) of the Communications Act which asks the FCC to preempt the jurisdiction of the Virginia State Corporation Commission. Starpower states that the Virginia Commission has failed to act when requested to resolve interconnection disputes between Starpower and Bell Atlantic-Virginia, Inc. and between Starpower and GTE South, Incorporated (GTE-South). Starpower requests that the FCC assume jurisdiction over its interconnection disputes with BA-Virginia and GTE-South

Oppositions or responses to these comments may be filed with the Secretary, FCC no later than **April 14, 2000**. More than a one or two sentence description of the views and arguments presented is generally required. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b)(2), as revised. Other rules pertaining to oral and written presentations are set forth in section 1.1206(b) as well. Interested parties are to file with the Secretary, FCC, and serve Janice M. Myles and ITS, with copies of any written *ex parte* presentations or summaries of oral *ex parte* presentations in these proceedings in the manner specified above.
