Amendment

Southwestern Bell Communications Services ("SBCS") is amending its international Section 214 Application (ITC-214-20000127-00027) to provide international facilities-based and resale services between all points in Texas and all international points except countries listed on the Commission's exclusion list ("Application"). In its Application, SBCS inadvertently omitted NetCom ASA ("NetCom") from the list of foreign carriers with which it is affiliated, within the meaning of Section 63.09 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.09. According to SBCS, NetCom is a competitive wireless carrier in Norway providing GSM mobile telecommunications services and has less than a 50 percent share of the markets for international transport, intercity and local access facilities and services in Norway.
