## STEVEN WEINGARTEN TO BECOME SPECIAL COUNSEL TO THE BUREAU CHIEF OF THE WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU

Thomas Sugrue, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, has named Steven Weingarten Special Counsel to the Office of the Bureau Chief.

Since March 1998, Weingarten has served as Chief of the Bureau's Commercial Wireless Division.
