By the Chief, Common Carrier Bureau:

On July 20, 2001, the Commission released a Memorandum Opinion and Order in the above-captioned docket authorizing Verizon New York Inc., *et al.*, to provide in-region, interLATA service in the state of Connecticut.¹ Due to a ministerial error, the Commission released an incorrect version of the statutory appendix set forth in Appendix D of the above-referenced order.
