SAT-STA-20020711-00099 E PanAmSat Licensee Corp.
Special Temporary Authority

PanAmSat Licensee Corp. has filed a request for Special Temporary Authority for up to 180 days, commencing on August 15, 2002, to: (1) relocate PAS-9 from 58.1° W.L. to 26.1° E.L.; and (2) operate the C-band payload and TT&C frequencies on the spacecraft at 26.1° E.L. PanAmSat is operating PAS-9 as an in-orbit spare at 58.1° W.L. pursuant to an STA. PanAmSat will not operate the communications payload on PAS-9 during its relocation; only the TT&C payload will be in use at that time. At 26.1° E.L., PAS-9 will provide back-up and supplemental capacity for Arabsat 2A.
