**ERRATUM**

**Released: October 29, 2002**

1. On September 26, 2002, the Commission released a *Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in IB Docket No. 00-248, inviting comment on proposals to streamline the process for earth station licenses.<sup>1</sup> In footnote 97, the last sentence is corrected to read as follows:

However, the Commission does not preempt local governments' and property owners' restrictions that require professional installations of transmitting antennas. *Competitive Networks Order*, FCC 00-366, 15 FCC Rcd at 23036 (para. 119).
