ERRATUM

By the Deputy Chief, Public Safety and Private Wireless Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau:

1. On December 5, 2002, the Acting Chief, Public Safety and Private Wireless Division released an *Order* (DA 02-3371) extending the time to respond to the *BLS License Inventory Public Notice* by forty-five days. The *Order* erroneously listed the new response date as January 21, 2003. In fact, the new response date is February 3, 2003. Therefore, all references to “January 21, 2003” in the *Order* are corrected to read “February 3, 2003.”

2. In addition, footnote 6 of the *Order* is corrected to read as follows:

Given that the forty-fifth day is a Sunday, we will extend the filing deadline to the next business day, Monday, February 3, 2003.
